Maintain control of your work.

The UC Open Access Policy gives faculty the right to retain legal control over use of their scholarly works. Share your work broadly and enable greater recognition for your research.

Sharing your work is easy.

Log on to UC's eScholarship to upload your article. Watch for the harvesting tool to help manage publications and deposit -- coming June 2014.
