Overview

This document covers upgrading the 64bit version Shibboleth SP on CentOS.

Upgrade

It is always a good idea to backup the contents of `/etc/shibboleth` before you begin. And you **must** backup `/etc/httpd/conf.d/shibd.conf` as it gets blown away.

To upgrade, do the following:

```
sudo yum -y --enablerepo=security_shibboleth update shibboleth.x86_64
```

Put back `/etc/httpd/conf.d/shibd.conf` and make any necessary changes to files in `/etc/shibboleth` if the install process reported any errors.

Restart Apache and shibd

Restart Apache and shibd to make sure Apache has the updated config in `/etc/httpd/conf.d/shibd.conf`.

```
sudo /sbin/service shibd restart
sudo /sbin/service httpd restart
```
